評価方法及び評価基準	Student presentations (graded on content, English accuracy, and presentation style using a rubric): (3 X 15 pts: 45pts) 45%; Research paper (7 pages long about a topic of Western Culture; it will be graded on content and English accuracy using a scoring rubric): 35%; Homework, classroom, IVE Project participation, and English Department cultural event participation: 20%									
課題等	Missed assignments should be submitted before the following class; the student is responsible for submitting missed assignments. Students will be asked to use their smartphones for class assignments every week.									
事前事後学修	Pre-class reading materials and assignments should be completed and understood before coming to class. Expected preparation time: 30 mins. / day.									
教材教科書参考書	There is no assigned textbook; the professor will provide handouts and materials. Students must have access to a smartphone or notebook computer for classroom activities, reviewing materials and submitting assignments via Teams. Students will participate in the IVE Online Intercultural Collaboration Project, so access to the internet is a must.
